The Competitor returning the best scratch score will be declared the winner and will receive a replica of the 'Kent Cob'. There will also be prizes for the runner-up and third place. There will be first, second and third handicap prizes, no Competitor can receive more than one prize. The Competition is open to all Amateur Golfers aged 16 years and over who hold an official Club handicap of six or under at the time of entry (see condition 6 below). The entrance fee is £42.00 which includes coffee on arrival, buffet lunch and tea after play. Two Prizes will also be given, one for the best combined gross score (72 holes), and the other for the best combined net score (72 holes) for the "Kent Cob" and the "Bishop's Bowl". The latter will be played at the Wildernesse Club on 5th September 2010.

CONDITIONS

1. Play is by Medal Play, 36 holes, and will be played under the rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, St Andrews, in conjunction with the local rules of Knole Park Golf Club.
2. Entries, together with the entrance fee, must be made on the form herewith and reach the General Manager, Knole Park Golf Club, Sevenoaks by Saturday 14th August 2010. Additional entry forms may be obtained on application to the Asst. Secretary or downloaded from the KPGC website at www.knoleparkgolfclub.co.uk
3. All competitors must have an 'active' handicap and will play under their CONGU handicap for the handicap prize. A certificate is incorporated in the entrance form. **CURRENT HANDICAP CERTIFICATES MUST BE PRODUCED ON THE DAY.**
4. Competitors wishing to play with any particular partner must notify the General Manager on entry. A copy of the draw with starting times will be forwarded to each competitor. Competitors may give the time they wish to start and every effort will be made to comply as far as possible with their request.
5. The Committee of Knole Park Golf Club is in charge of the Competition. Any dispute or matter requiring settlement shall be referred to it, and its decision shall be final. In the event of a tie, the winner shall be decided on a sudden death play off.
6. Entries will be limited to 50, lower handicaps being given preference. This may result in a ballot of higher handicaps.
7. **Dress – Competitors may wear smart casual in the Dining Room, but must change out of soiled golfing clothes. Jacket/Blazer and tie should be worn for the Prize Giving.**
8. Competitors withdrawing after Thursday 26th August 2010 will not have their entrance fee refunded.
9. Mobile phones are not to be used in or around the Clubhouse or on the course except in an emergency.
10. Distance measuring equipment is permitted on the course under local rule 9.

Competitors may have the courtesy of the course on Tuesday 24th August (1330 – 1700), but must report to the Professional before availing themselves of this facility.
